If you are accepted to active duty, you will be put on for a probationary period, during which time you will be expected to complete required training. You will also be given a copy of the Woodbine Fire & Rescue Constitution, Bylaws, and Regulations.

Training and Membership Requirements

Woodbine Fire and Rescue is a close group of individuals. Our members are highly trained and work very well together. We have 12 regular meetings a year. These meetings take place on the 1st Tuesday of the month. Training takes place before the regular meeting. Our Constitution requires that you attend as many of these meetings as possible but you cannot miss more than 5 in a calendar year. Members are expected to take state required training. All training is paid for by the department and is very costly, therefore it is very important to retain members. If you have any more questions please contact a member from the division you wish to join.

Member Required Training

- CPR certified at the healthcare level.
- Defensive driving.

Rescue Training

- The EMT-Basic program is a 144-hour course that takes 12-14 weeks to complete.
- Woodbine, on average, has 175 rescue calls per year.

Fire Training

- Fire Fighter 1 is a 96-hour course that takes 8-10 weeks to complete.
- Fire Apparatus Training.
- Annual Pack Test.
